

**LETTER OF INTENT
ON ENVIRONMENTAL COOPERATION
BETWEEN THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY OF
THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

AND

**THE MINISTRY OF INFRASTRUCTURE AND THE ENVIRONMENT OF
THE KINGDOM OF THE NETHERLANDS**

The Environmental Protection Agency of the State of California of the United States and the Ministry of Infrastructure and the Environment of the Kingdom of the Netherlands (hereinafter referred to as “the Two Parties”), through friendly consultation, intend to cooperate in the coming two years on the following environmental fields:

Article I. Sustainable Mobility

With great satisfaction, the Two Parties refer to the Memorandum of Understanding between California Plug-in Electric Vehicle Collaborative and Coast to Coast e-Mobility Connection, signed October 30, 2013 in Sacramento, California. They endorse the MoU that has been signed by and will be executed under the responsibility of the respective parties for a period of at least two years.

Article II. Climate & Energy


The Two Parties will continue to exchange information through their respective government channels with regard to climate and energy policies, specifically to broaden the worldwide coalition of states that aim to have green growth through more energy efficiency, a bigger share of renewable energy and a cap-and-trade system for their greenhouse gas emissions.
